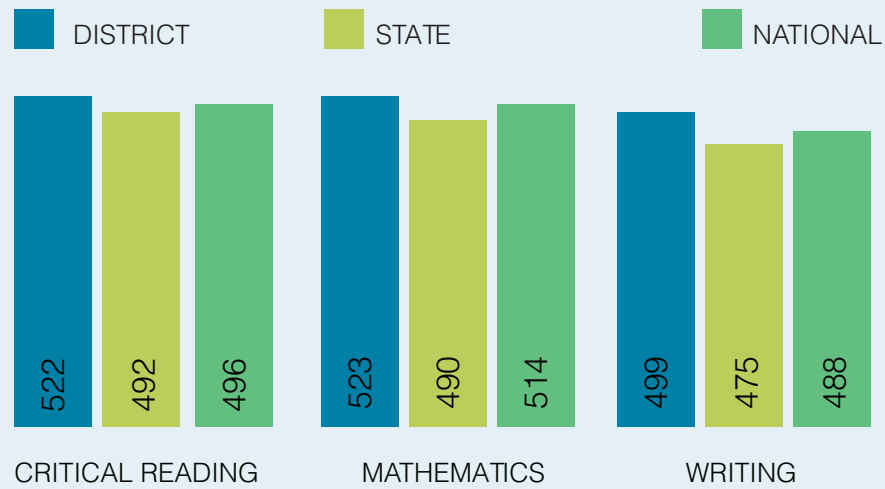


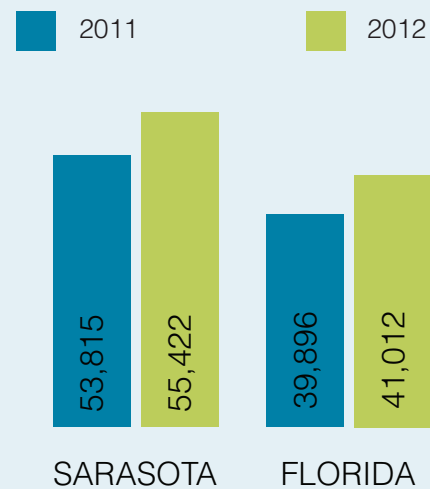

AVERAGE SAT SCORES



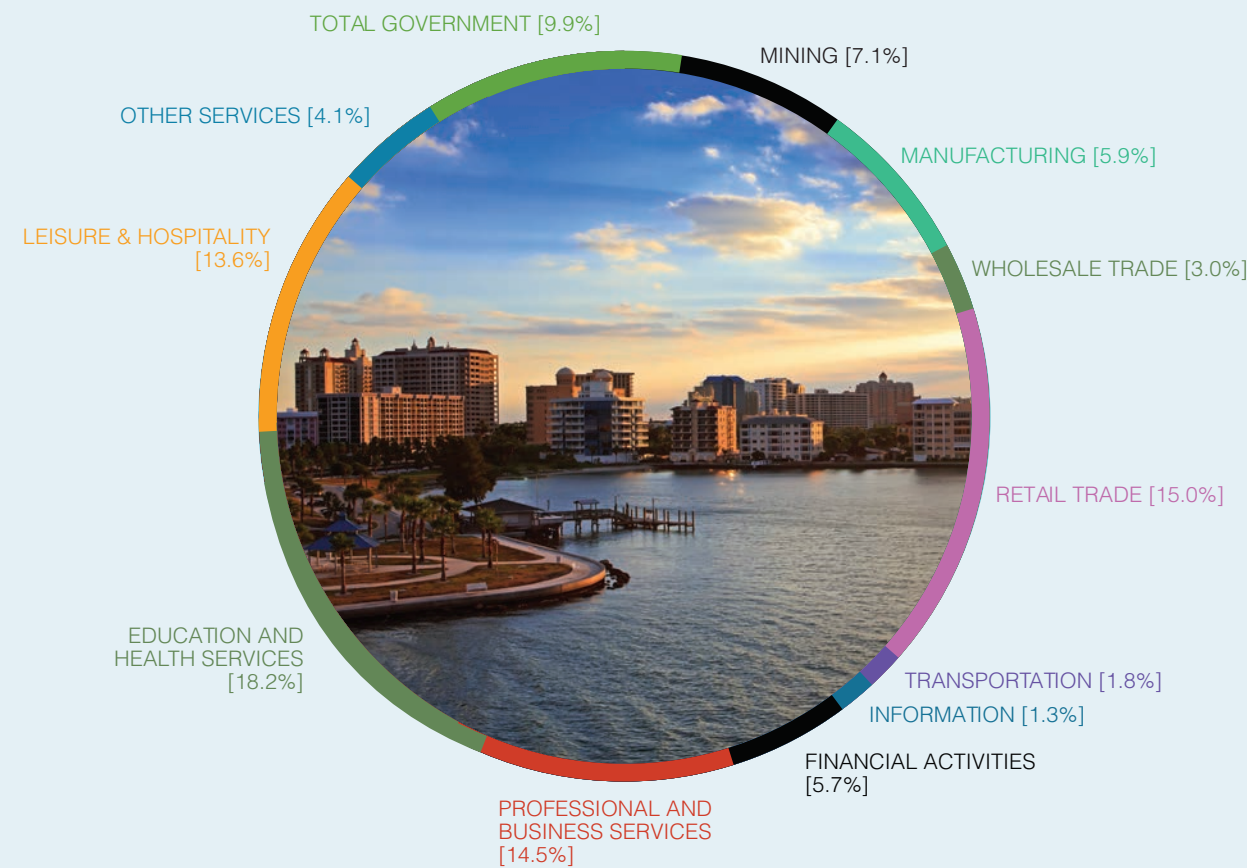

PER CAPITA INCOME



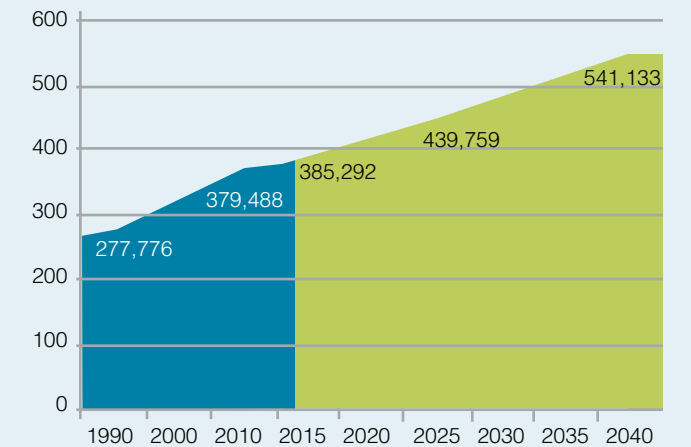

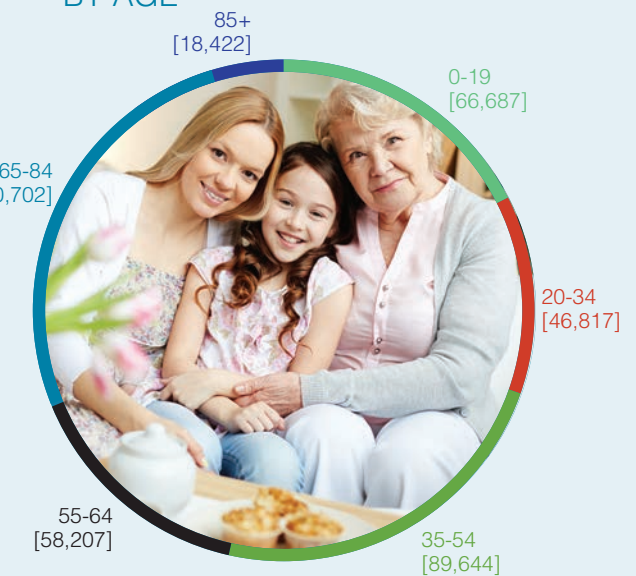

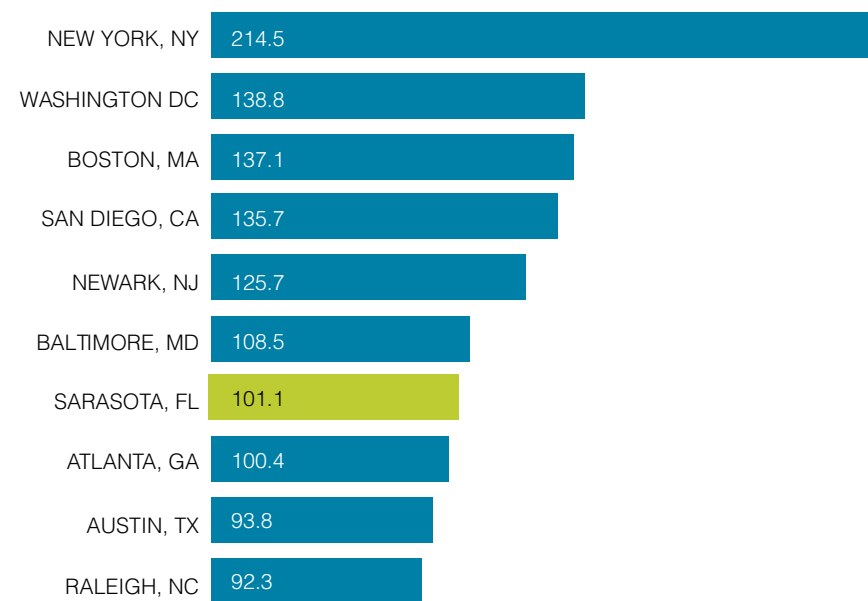
POPULATION JURISDICTIONS

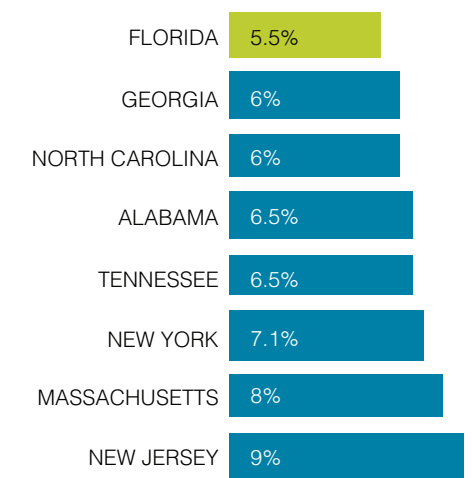

COST OF LIVING 100= U.S. AVERAGE



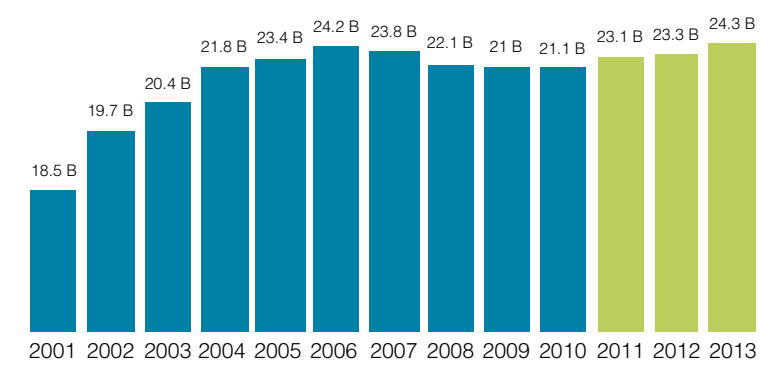

TAX RATES



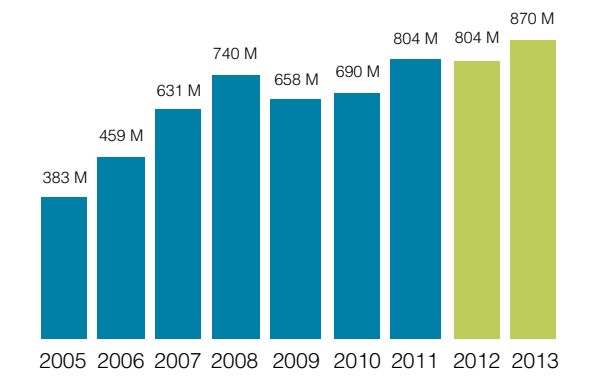

REAL GDP



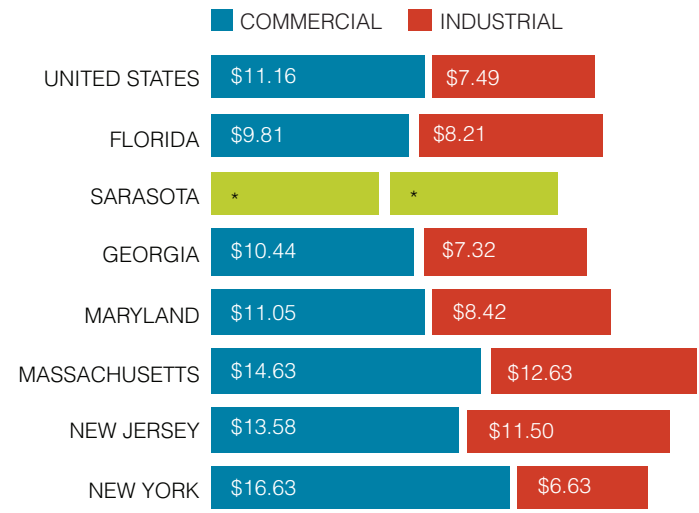

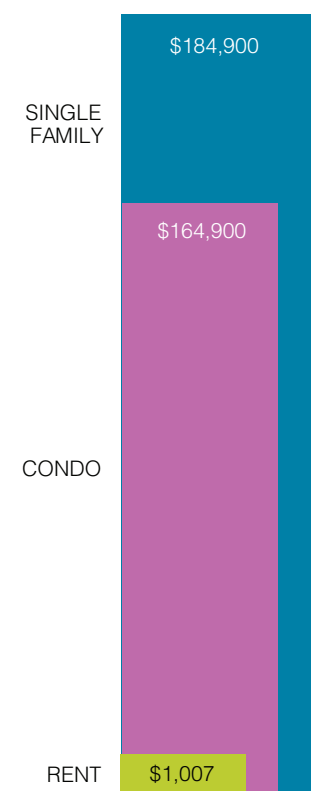

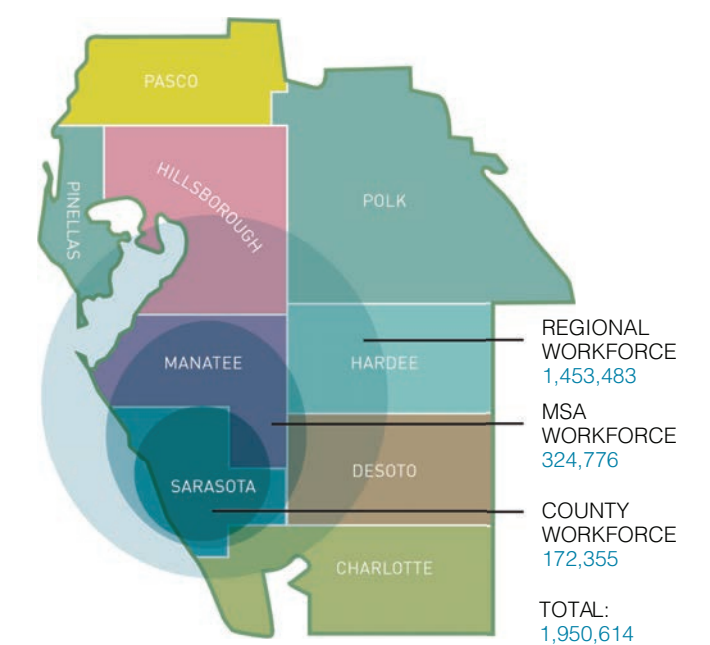
